Update for 2013 Great Lakes Nuclear Hot Spots Map as of January 2014

- Some proposed Canadian sites for a deep geological repository for Canada's irradiated fuel (small inset map) have been eliminated by the Nuclear Waste Management Organization (NWMO): Arran-Elderslie, Saugeen Shores, English-River First Nation, Pinehouse, Ear Falls, and Wawa.
- A proposed reactor, Fermi 3, for Monroe, Michigan, was inadvertently left off of this edition of the map.
- The Kewaunee reactor in Wisconsin is now closed.
- Newbuild at Darlington (up to 4 new reactors proposed) has been indefinitely shelved.
- Great Lakes United, one of the co-producers of this map, closed its doors in 2013 and its website is no longer in use. The important work that this historic coalition accomplished will continue to assist our communities in the Great Lakes/St. Lawrence River watersheds for a very long time.
